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
Replacing the rotary drive arm

Precondition:

- ☑ Instrument is disconnected from the main supply.
- Remove all connections.
- Remove all accessories.
- Remove all glass parts.
- Remove the heating bath.








Remove the screw.

- Slide the flat screwdriver through the forming gap to release the clip.
